SUBJECT: H.B. 529, H.D. 1 - RELATING TO CARE HOMES

Hearing: Thursday, March 14, 2013; 1:20 p.m. Conference Room 016, State Capitol

PURPOSE: The purpose of H.B. 529, H.D. 1, is to require all operators of adult

foster homes, assisted living facilities, expanded adult residential care homes,

community care foster family homes, and developmental disabilities domiciliary homes to

hold a sufficient amount of liability insurance.

DEPARTMENT'S POSITION: The Department of Human Services (DHS)

supports the intent of Section 1 of this bill but has concerns on the language in Section 1. The DHS respectfully requests that "assisted living facilities as defined in section 346-331" and "expanded adult residential care homes as defined in section 36-331" be deleted from Section 1. These facilities are under the jurisdiction of the Department of Health (DOH) and not the DHS. The DHS currently administers only the community care foster family homes which will transfer to the DOH on July 1, 2014.

The DOH has the licensing authority over the Assisted Living Facilities (ALF), the Expanded Adult Residential Care Homes (EARCHs), and the developmental disabilities domiciliary homes. The DHS becomes involved with these facilities when a Medicaid

client is placed in the facility and payment for services is needed. In order to be paid, the facility must have a contract with a health plan. Liability insurance is a requirement for the health plan contract.

The DHS defers to the DOH regarding the provisions of Sections 2 to 4 that pertain to the facilities under DOH's jurisdiction.

Dear Senator Chun Oakland and Members of the Committee:

SUBJECT: HB 529 HD1 – RELATING TO CARE HOMES

The State Council on Developmental Disabilities (DD) **SUPPORTS THE INTENT OF HB 529 HD1.** The bill requires all operators of adult foster homes, assisted living facilities, expanded adult residential care homes, community care foster family homes, and DD domiciliary homes to hold a sufficient amount of liability insurance.

We are aware that Act 266, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, required liability insurance coverage for operators of adult foster homes, adult residential care homes, assisted living facilities, and expanded residential care homes. However, DD domiciliary homes were not included in Act 266/12. HD 529 HD1 includes these homes in Section 4 as requiring liability insurance.

With regards to Section 2, Page 2, line 3, "<u>and intellectual disabilities</u>," the Council would like to clarify that this phrase should not imply that an individual residing in an adult foster home must have both DD and intellectual disabilities. An individual can have DD but not have intellectual disabilities. To be consistent with Chapter 333F-Services for Persons with Developmental or Intellectual Disabilities, the phrase "and intellectual disabilities" should be replaced with "<u>or intellectual disabilities</u>" for the following:

- 1) Section 2, Page 2, line 3
- 2) Section 2, Page 2, line 7
