My name is Ron Carlson. I have practiced dental surgery in Honolulu since 1970. Unexamined "human wisdom" would have us believe that "we most always know what is best for nature and ourselves through our modern science." You and 1 know that this is not so, but Corporate America and its State Universities, who wish to "sell" their concepts and products, keep on suggesting and insisting that they have the answers to our problems.

#### But, they don't!

Endlessly, and sadly, we have seen the *ill results* of man's folly, man's wisdom manipulating our environment. A few examples, if you will, of "the science of man" that is directed by Directive Heads:

- 1) Heptachlor in the 70's was a huge issue. The experts ensured us, that there would be no problems relating to its use on cane and pine, but it got into the milk of our cows, to the children, and we had an emergency on our hands, did we not? It got into our wells too, and to my knowledge is still present.
- 2) Remember the mongoose? Classically tragic, if not hilarious in a sense. Brought here to quell the rodent population, they were like ships passing in the night, for one operated by day the other by night.
