A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ANTIQUE MOTOR VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 249-31, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

3 "§249-31 State registration fee. (a) All vehicles and motor vehicles in the State as defined in section 249-1, 4 5 [including] except antique motor vehicles $[\tau]$ which shall be 6 subject to a \$25 annual vehicle registration fee, and except as otherwise provided in sections 249-4 and 249-6, shall be subject 7 8 to a \$45 annual vehicle registration fee. The fee shall be paid each year together with all other taxes and fees levied by this 9 10 chapter on a staggered basis as established by each county as 11 authorized by section 286-51, and the state registration for 12 that county shall likewise be staggered so that the state 13 registration fee is due and payable at the same time and shall 14 be collected together with the county fee. The state 15 registration fee shall be deemed delinquent if not paid with the 16 county registration fee. The respective counties shall collect 17 this fee together with the vehicle registration tax collected

Re: H.B. 75, Relating to Antique Motor Vehicles

The Department provides the following information and comments for your consideration. H.B. 75 amends the State Vehicle Weight Tax and State registration fee for antique motor vehicles. This bill would change the weight tax on antique vehicles from 1.75 cents per pound to 1.00 cent per pound. The annual registration fee would change from \$45 to \$25 per antique vehicle. The reduction in registration fee revenue would be absorbed entirely by the general fund and would not affect the emergency medical services special fund.

The Department suggests the bill may be improved by placing the different rates for antique motor vehicles into separate subsections.
