1 EOA's Position: The Executive Office on Aging (EOA) supports the intent of this measure,

2 provided that its enactment does not reduce or replace priorities within our Biennium Budget

7 **Purpose and Justification:** EOA supports the concept of the Hawaii Kupuna Trust Fund as a

8 creative way of financing programs and services to strengthen elderly and vulnerable adult care.
