OVERVIEW OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

This measure allows the directors of the Departments of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, of Health, of Human Services, and of Labor and Industrial Relations to select a designee for all Hawaii Health Connector meetings.

The department <u>strongly supports</u> the Senate Draft 1 of this proposal. The Board often calls meetings on short notice and the program staff that supports the Director is part of a small unit with multiple responsibilities.

II. CURRENT LAW

The Director of Labor and Industrial Relations (DLIR), or the director's designee, is an exofficio, voting member of the Board as so specified under Act 205 of 2011 (codified as Hawaii Revised Statute Chapter 435).

III. COMMENTS ON THE HOUSE BILL

The proposal allows the Director to voice his vote through his designee when he is unable to attend the meetings of the Board of Directors. Board meetings may be scheduled on very short notice and the Director may not always be available given his daily responsibilities. The Director's designee with <u>voting</u> privileges, furthermore, will count towards constituting a quorum and will facilitate the transactions of the Board or committee in a timely manner.

<u>PURPOSE</u>: The purpose of H.B. 877, H.D. 1, S.D. 1, is to allow the directors of the Departments of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, of Health, of Human Services, and of Labor and Industrial Relations to delegate voting authority to their designees for a specified meeting or meetings.

<u>DEPARTMENT'S POSITION</u>: The Department of Human Services (DHS) strongly supports this Administration bill.

The successful operation of the Hawaii Health Connector will allow Hawaii's resident to take full advantage of the Affordable Health Care Act benefits and will ensure a seamless integration with the Department of Human Services' medical assistance programs.

Act 205, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, codified as chapter 435H, Hawaii Revised

Statutes, established the Hawaii Health Insurance Exchange as a Hawaii nonprofit

corporation. The corporation is also known as the Hawaii Health Connector. Section 435H-4(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes, specifies that the directors of the Departments of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, of Health, of Human Services, and of Labor and Industrial Relations or their respective designees shall be ex-officio voting members of the board of directors of the Hawaii Health Insurance Exchange.

Allowing the directors of the named departments to select a designee for specified meeting or meetings will ensure the voting representation that is critical for the successful development and implementation of the Hawaii Health Insurance Exchange. Also, a voting quorum may not be met without the directors' designees.

The implementation of a health insurance exchange is necessary for meeting the requirements of the federal Affordable Health Care Act.
