In consideration of HOUSE BILL 989 RELATING TO FISH

House Bill 989 proposes to increase criminal penalties for violations of Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) §188-31, relating to aquarium permits by authorizing a *per specimen* fine. The Department of Land and Natural Resources ("Department") <u>supports this measure, but suggest</u> <u>amendments.</u>

The Department is currently authorized to impose criminal and civil fines for violations of aquatic resource laws. Prior to 1999, there was a *per specimen* fine in HRS §188-70. That was repealed by Act 195, Session Laws of Hawaii 1999.

The Department recommends amending proposed HB989 as follows:

- 1. Move the *per specimen* fine provision from HRS §188-31 into the penalty sections: HRS §187A-13, §188-70, §189-4, and §190-5. This would authorize the Department to use *per specimen* fines and penalties for <u>all aquatic resource law violations</u> instead of only aquarium fishing violations.
- 2. Amend HRS § 187A-5 to authorize the Department to adopt administrative rules specifying how *per specimen* fines are to be calculated and applied.
