In consideration of HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 227 REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO SUBMIT A FINANCIAL REPORT ON THE COSTS OF MANAGING WAO KELE O PUNA

House Concurrent Resolution 227 requests that the Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) submit a financial report on the costs of managing Wao Kele O Puna. The **Department has the following comments.**

The 25,856 acre Wao Kele O Puna Reserve has several important natural and cultural resources in need of protection. The Department is working closely with the Office of Hawaiian Affairs (OHA) to assure the proper management of Wao Kele O Puna. The Department continues to work towards the transition where OHA will have full management responsibility of the area by 2016 target. Over the past year, more management activities have shifted to OHA staff. The Department continues to support these efforts. The Department has shared all of its financial information with OHA and continue to work cooperatively.
