TESTIMONY ON HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 66, REQUESTING THE STATE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A SUNRISE REVIEW OF THE REGULATION OF VETERINARY TECHNICIANS AND THE PRACTICE OF VETERINARY TECHNOLOGY.

TO THE HONORABLE ANGUS L.K. MCKELVEY, CHAIR, AND MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE:

My name is John Kaya, D.V.M., and I am the Chairperson of the Board of Veterinary Examiners ("Board"). Thank you for the opportunity to present testimony in support of House Concurrent Resolution No. 66, Requesting the State Auditor to Conduct a Sunrise Review of the Regulation of Veterinary Technicians and the Practice

of Veterinary Technology.

The Board understands that Section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires

that new regulatory measures being considered for enactment be referred to the Auditor

for a sunrise analysis. Referral shall be by concurrent resolution that identifies a

specific legislative bill to be analyzed, which in this case is Senate Bill No. 2502, S.D. 1

(2014). The statute further requires that the analysis shall set forth the probable effects

of regulation, assess whether its enactment is consistent with the legislative policies of

the Hawaii Regulatory Licensing Reform Act, and assess alternative forms of regulation.

The Board worked with the proponents of the bill and compromise language was reached, and Senate Bill No. 2502, S.D. 1, is the bill to be analyzed by the Auditor. Affected parties are in full support of establishing requirements for the regulation of veterinary technicians and the practice of veterinary technology.

For the Committee's information, the companion measure, Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 46, was heard by the Senate Committee on Commerce and Consumer Protection on March 21, 2014, and it passed out unamended.

Thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony in support of House Concurrent Resolution No. 66.
