HCR 59/HR 45 - Urging Hawaiian Electric Company, Inc. to Return Its' Call Center Operations to Hawaii

Chairs Tsuji and Nakashima, and Members of the Committees:

My name is Enrique Che and I am testifying on behalf of Hawaiian Electric Company and its subsidiaries Maui Electric Company and Hawaii Electric Light Company. We are offering comments on these resolutions.

The Companies' Call Center Operations have always remained in Hawaii.

In May of 2012 the Companies embarked on the replacement of our customer information and billing system. In preparation for this change, additional call center staff was hired at all three companies. Due to the necessary training, initial anticipated call influx, and learning curve of utilizing a new system for our call center employees, a third-party call center that specialized in utility type calls was hired as an <u>interim</u> solution to supplement our staff until service levels and performance are stabilized.

Although there is an increasing trend for companies nationwide to utilize more affordable outsourcing options, we support hiring Hawaii employees. Hawaii Electric Light Company has already returned all call handling to in-house. It is our intent that eventually all transactional calls will be handled in-house by Hawaiian Electric and Maui Electric call center staff. Hawaiian Electric continues to add capacity to its local call center operations by hiring more representatives to meet the higher call demands. The mainland call center is still needed at this time to provide supplemental assistance in answering calls and to allow current staff to complete additional training as we continue to strive to provide our customers with the quality level of service that they desire. It is also important at this stage of our technology development to provide a contingency option for calls should anything happen locally, which is critical during emergencies.
