PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE VII, SECTION 13, OF THE HAWAII STATE CONSTITUTION

Senate Bill No. 1034 proposes to amend Article VII, Section 13, of the Hawaii State

Constitution to exempt refunding general obligation bonds from the requirement that all general obligation bonds for a term exceeding two years shall be in serial form maturing in substantially equal installments of principal, or maturing in substantially equal installments of both principal and interest.

The Department strongly supports this administration measure. Refunding general obligation bonds with level debt service often limits the State's ability to efficiently structure refunding bond issues. The proposed amendment will allow the State to refund those maturities that are strategically advantageous, and structure refunding bond issues that will enhance the State's overall debt profile rather than being limited to a level debt service requirement.
