<u>PURPOSE</u>: The purpose of S.B. 1116 is to expand the definition of "public housing

projects" to include all potential properties that could be managed by a public housing

agency under federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations.

DEPARTMENT'S POSITION: The Department of Human Services (DHS) supports this Administration bill to expand the definition of "public housing project". Expanding the definition as proposed will enable the HPHA to manage additional publicly assisted properties, encouraging the increased development of the State's affordable housing stock, improving revenues for the agency thereby reducing required public funding, and allowing for more efficient housing development and management by the State.
