## SB 1124, Relating to the Dietitian Licensure Special Fund

- 1 **Department's Position:** Comments.
- 2 Fiscal Implications: Decreases General Fund dependency.

3 Purpose and Justification: This bill is part of the Governor's Administrative Package. SB 1124 is a

4 housekeeping bill that establishes expenditure limits necessary for the department to expend these funds

- 5 to offset operational costs; current statute does not adequately identify expenditure limits.
- 6
- 7 The Dietitian Licensure Special Fund is an existing fund into which fees for profession licensing are
- 8 deposited. The State's dietitian licensure program was implemented by the department in August 2012
- 9 and issued licenses to 12 dietitians as of November 30, 2012, with more applications in process.
- 10 Licensure fees totaling approximately \$3,000 have been collected and deposited into the Special Fund.
- 11 Once this bill becomes law, the department will be able to expend moneys in support of the licensure

12 program.
