Testimony of Loretta J. Fuddy, A.C.S.W., M.P.H. Director of Health

April 1, 2013

Department's Position: The Department of Health supports this measure to amend the Hawaii Revised

2 Statutes to create a state definition of Hawaii's rural areas for the purposes of qualifying these areas to

3 be eligible for federal rural programs and funds.

4 **Fiscal Implications:** None to Department of Health.

5 **Purpose and Justification:** This bill will help protect existing programs that maintain valuable health

6 care services to their communities, such as Kahuku Medical Center's critical access hospital

7 designation, and keeps areas of Oahu that are widely considered eligible for federal rural health

8 programs, such as the Rural Health Outreach Initiative and the Rural Network Development Program.

9 Programs such as these help to ensure a remote community's access to primary and emergency care

10 services. Furthermore, it permits the Department of Health's Office of Primary Care and Rural Health to

11 continue to provide technical assistance to these communities using their federal rural funding.

- 12 Federal rural programs recognize that states have better understanding of its geography and
- 13 demographics, and are in a better position to define their rural areas. The Department believes this
- 14 definition is equitable and captures the public understanding of what constitutes rural areas in Hawaii.
