1 **Department's Position:** Support with Reservations.

2 Fiscal Implications: One general funded registered nurse (RN V) position would be required. Annual

3 expenses are estimated to be approximately \$120,000 including travel costs (mileage and neighbor

4 island travel).

Purpose and Justification: In 2009 the legislature passed what became Act 21, Special Session Laws 5 of Hawaii 2009. The purpose of Act 21 was to protect consumers of home care services by requiring 6 home care agencies to be licensed. DOH supports this intent and has collaborated with home care 7 agencies, consumer advocates and other stakeholders to draft the administrative rules needed to 8 implement licensing in the event resources became available. Those draft rules are in the last stage of 9 the approval process. However, this activity cannot be absorbed by current licensing and support staff 10 or resources without negatively impacting other licensing activities. 11 As a result, the department supports this measure so long as any appropriation does not adversely 12 impact priorities in the Governor's Executive Budget. 13
