## TESTIMONY BY KALBERT K. YOUNG DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FINANCE STATE OF HAWAII TO THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON LABOR & PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT ON SENATE BILL NO. 2074, S.D. 1

March 11, 2014

#### MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS

This measure is a vehicle bill to appropriate and authorize funds for collective bargaining cost items for salary adjustments, other cost adjustments, and Hawaii Employer-Union Health Benefit Trust costs for public employees represented by the Hawaii Government Employees Association (HGEA) belonging to Bargaining Unit 9 (registered nurses) and their excluded counterparts for Fiscal Biennium 2013-15.

HGEA and the public employers have reached a tentative agreement concerning Collective Bargaining Unit 9 (registered nurses). The State received notification of ratification on February 27, 2014. Notification of cost item amounts was submitted to the Legislature on February 28, 2014.

The attached Proposed H.D. 1 contains the appropriation amounts required to fund the agreement. Please note that a small correction has been made to the FY 2014-2015 included Hawaii Employer-Union Health Benefits Trust Fund costs in the attached bill compared to the February 28 submittal.

It should be noted that most of special fund costs for this agreement are to be borne by the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation (HHSC). HHSC has indicated that it cannot absorb these additional salary costs and will be requesting an increase in its general fund subsidy from the Legislature for this purpose.
