In consideration of SENATE BILL 2877, SENATE DRAFT 1, HOUSE DRAFT 1 RELATING TO USE PERMITS FOR SMALL BOAT HARBOR FACILITIES

Senate Bill 2877, Senate Draft 1, House Draft 1 proposes to clarify that no use permit for a state small boat harbor facility may be transferred unless specifically provided by law. The **Department of Land and Natural Resources strongly supports this Administration** measure.

This bill proposes to clarify that use permits issued to a corporation or other business entity or is part of a controlled group for a state small boat facility may only be transferred if the corporation of other business entity holds a valid commercial use permit. It also clarifies that if a corporation is owned by another corporation, any change in ownership of either corporation constitutes as a transfer. This will ensure that the issuance of use permits for small boat harbors and related facilities are done fairly and prevents people from being exempt from paying a transfer fee by forming multiple corporations.
