My name is Michael Hamnett, Executive Director of the Research Corporation of the University of Hawaii. Thank you for the opportunity to submit testimony on SB 732, which adds the Director of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism (DBEDT), or the Director's Designee, to the Board of Directors of the Research Corporation of the University of Hawaii.

RCUH supports SB 732 with one change.

We support the addition of the Director of DBEDT to the RCUH Board as an ex-officio member, but suggest that it be as a non-voting member. This will be consistent with another Senate Bill that adds the UH Vice President for Research to the RCUH Board as an ex-officio, non-voting member.

RCUH services a number of State of Hawaii agencies, so the addition of the Director of DBEDT will provide representation from that client base. The DBEDT Director can make meaningful contributions to RCUH by sharing the State's perspective on issues that may affect the research, training, and economic development initiatives that RCUH is involved in.
