SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 101 / SENATE RESOLUTION 67 AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A TERM, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT COVERING A PORTION OF STATE SUBMERGED LANDS AT MOKULEIA. WAIALUA, OAHU, FOR THE USE, MAINTENANCE, AND REPAIR OF AN EXISTING SEAWALL AND STEP

Senate Concurrent Resolution 101/Senate Resolution 67 request the authorization to issue a term, non-exclusive easement covering 101 square feet, more or less, portion of state submerged lands fronting the property identified as tax map key: (1) 6-8-004: seaward of 014, at Mokuleia, Waialua, Oahu for maintenance and repair of existing seawall and step constructed thereon, pursuant to Section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS). The Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) supports these concurrent resolutions.

The owner of the abutting property, Ms. Christine Fuss, was in the process of obtaining a shoreline certification. During the survey process, portion of the seawall and step were found encroaching on State lands located makai of the shoreline and therefore considered as submerged lands. As required by Section 171-53, HRS, the Board of Land and Natural Resources (Board) may lease submerged lands "with the prior approval of the Governor and the prior authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution". At its meeting on December 14, 2012, under agenda item D-16, the Board approved the issuance of a new term, non-exclusive easement for seawall and step purposes.

The Lessee is required to pay the State the fair market value of the easement as consideration for the use of public lands. The amount of consideration is to be determined by independent appraisal.
