HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TWENTY-SEVENTH LEGISLATURE, 2014 STATE OF HAWAII H.B. NO. H.D. 1

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOLD STAR FAMILY DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is a need to
- 2 honor, support, and cherish the families of the United States
- 3 armed forces members who have bravely sacrificed their lives for
- 4 their country.
- 5 On June 23, 1936, a joint congressional resolution
- 6 designated the last Sunday in September as Gold Star Mother's
- 7 Day to honor the mothers of the men and women who have given
- 8 their lives for their country while serving in the United States
- 9 armed forces in times of war or conflict. Gold Star Mother's
- 10 Day has been observed every year since by presidential
- 11 proclamation. In September 2009, President Barack Obama renamed
- 12 the last day in September as Gold Star Mother's and Family's Day
- 13 and included family members as part of the honorees.
- 14 A total of seven states, Illinois, North Dakota, New
- 15 Jersey, New York, Ohio, Tennessee, and Wisconsin, as well as
- 16 Guam have enacted legislation to recognize Gold Star Mother's
- 17 and Family's Day.

- 1 The purpose of this Act is to establish Gold Star Family
- 2 Day in Hawaii as a specific day to honor the family members of
- 3 the men and women who have given their lives for their country
- 4 while serving with the United States armed forces in time of war
- 5 or during a period of hostilities.
- 6 SECTION 2. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 7 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 "S8- Gold Star Family Day. The last Sunday in September
- 10 shall be known as "Gold Star Family Day", in recognition of the
- 11 family members of the men and women who have given their lives
- 12 for their country while serving with the armed forces of the
- 13 United States in time of war or during a period of hostilities.
- 14 This day is not and shall not be construed to be a state
- 15 holiday."
- 16 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
