A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII LABOR RELATIONS BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 89-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:
3	"(e) Any action taken by the board shall be by a simple
4	majority of the members of the board. All decisions of the
5	board shall be reduced to writing and shall state separately its
6	finding of fact and conclusions. Any vacancy in the board shall
7	not impair the authority of the remaining members to exercise
8	all the powers of the board. The governor may appoint an acting
9	member of the board during the temporary absence from the State,
10	temporary inability to act due to recusal, or illness of any
11	regular member. An acting member, during the acting member's
12	term of service, shall have the same powers and duties as the
13	regular member; provided that:
14	(1) If the regular member is the representative of
15	[management or] labor, then employee organizations
16	representing public employees may submit to the
17	governor for consideration names of persons to serve

1		as an acting member and the governor shall first
2		consider these persons in selecting an acting member;
3	(2)	If the regular member is the representative of
4		management, then public employers may submit to the
5		governor for consideration names of persons to serve
6		as an acting member and the governor shall first
7		consider these persons in selecting an acting member;
8	(3)	Subsection (d) shall not apply to an acting member;
9		and
10	(4)	An acting member appointed due to a regular member's
11		recusal shall be appointed for the case in which the
12		recusal occurred, and the acting member's appointment
13		shall terminate when the final decision is filed or
14		the case is withdrawn."
15	SECT	ION 2. Section 89-5.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
16	amended t	o read as follows:
17	"[+]	§89-5.1[] Hearing notice. Notwithstanding section
18	91-9.5, i	n any hearing conducted by the board, all parties shall
19	be given	written notice of the hearing by first class mail or by
20	electroni	c service through a company designated by the board at
21	least fif	teen days before the scheduled date of the hearing."
