A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OUTDOOR HERITAGE MONTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. On September 2, 1937, the Federal Aid in
- 2 Wildlife Restoration Act, commonly referred to as the Pittman-
- 3 Robertson Act, was signed into law. Using funds from excise
- 4 taxes received from the sale of sporting arms and archery
- 5 equipment, the Pittman-Robertson Act provides federal assistance
- 6 to states for projects to manage, enhance, and restore wildlife
- 7 and to conduct state hunter education programs.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to recognize Hawaii's commitment
- 9 to the preservation of natural resources and promotion of
- 10 outdoor recreational activities by designating the month of June
- 11 as Outdoor Heritage Month.
- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 13 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 14 read as follows:
- 15 "§8- Outdoor heritage month. The month of June shall
- 16 be known and designated as "Outdoor Heritage Month" to celebrate
- 17 Hawaii's diverse natural environment and recreational
- 18 activities."
