A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THRILL CRAFT OPERATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Act 89, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, as amended
2	by Act 118, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013, is amended by amending
3	section 5 to read as follows:
4	"SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval[-
5	provided that on June 30, 2014, section 1 of this Act shall be
6	repealed on June 30, 2014; and provided further that section 2
7	of this Act shall take effect on July 1, 2014]."
8	SECTION 2. Act 89, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, as amended
9	by Act 118, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013, is amended by repealing
10	section 2.
11	[""SECTION 2: Section 200 37, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
12	amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
13	"(c) No person shall operate a thrill craft in the waters
14	of the State, except:
15	(1) In areas and during time periods designated by the
16	department;
17	(2) Through areas designated by the department to serve as
18	avenues for the ingress and egress of thrill craft
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1	between the areas designated under paragraph (1) and
2	the shore;
3	(3) Authorized government personnel conducting operations
4	approved by the department; or
5	(4) When used to conduct ocean cleanup, as authorized by
6	rules adopted by the department.""]
7	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
8	and stricken.
9	SECTION 4. This Act, upon its approval, shall take effect
10	on June 29, 2014.
