A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOTEL CLASS LIQUOR LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. 1 Section 281-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending the definition of "hotel" to read as 3 follows: 4 ""Hotel" means an establishment consisting of one or more buildings which contain $[\frac{(1)}{1}]$ such total number of rooms as may 5 6 be prescribed by the commission and in which rooms sleeping 7 accommodations are provided and offered for adequate pay to 8 transient or permanent guests [; and (2) a suitable and adequate 9 kitchen and dining room, where meals are regularly prepared and 10 served to hotel guests and other customers]." 11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 12 and stricken.
