A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PODIATRISTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to allow a qualified
- 2 podiatric physician to perform ankle fracture surgery and to
- 3 conform the definition of "podiatric medicine" to national
- 4 standards relative to diagnosis and treatment of the foot and
- 5 ankle.
- 6 SECTION 2. Chapter 463E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 8 and to read as follows:
- 9 "S463E- Qualifications; ankle fracture surgery. A
- 10 podiatric physician may perform ankle fracture surgery if the
- 11 podiatric physician is board qualified or board certified in
- 12 reconstructive rearfoot ankle surgery by the American Board of
- 13 Podiatric Surgery and has completed a thirty-six-month podiatric
- 14 surgical residency."
- 15 SECTION 3. Section 463E-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by amending the definition of "podiatric medicine" to
- 17 read as follows:

- 1 ""Podiatric medicine" means the medical, surgical,
- 2 mechanical, manipulative, and electrical diagnosis and treatment
- 3 of the human foot, malleoli, and [soft tissues about the] ankle,
- 4 [except for ankle fractures,] including the [nonsurgical]
- 5 surgical treatment of the muscles and tendons of the leg
- 6 governing the functions of the foot, but does not include [any]
- 7 amputation[reserve for digital amputation,] above the ankle,
- 8 treatment of systemic conditions, or the use of any anesthetic
- 9 except local anesthetic."
- 10 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
