A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is							
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated							
3	and to read as follows:							
4	"§286- All-terrain vehicle; utility-terrain vehicle;							
5	permitted use. (a) All-terrain vehicles and utility-terrain							
6	vehicles may be operated on a street, as defined in section							
7	291C-1; provided that the all-terrain vehicle or utility-terrain							
8	vehicle is:							
9	(1) Used as farm equipment, or used by a city, county,	<u>or</u>						
10	state worker while acting within the scope of that							
11	person's official duties;							
12	(2) Operated by a person who holds a current category (<u>3)</u>						
13	driver's license under section 286-102 or a commerc	ial						
14	driver's license under part XIII;							
15	(3) Driven on streets that are no more than two lanes,							
16	with posted speed limits of no more than thirty-fiv	<u>e</u>						
17	miles per hour;							

1	(4)	Used to travel between properties zoned for					
2		agriculture, or used by a city, county, or state					
3		worker while acting within the scope of that person's					
4		official duties to travel between properties under the					
5		jurisdiction of the city, county, or state;					
6	<u>(5)</u>	Used in counties with populations of less than five					
7		hundred thousand residents; and					
8	(6)	Driven on streets during daylight hours; provided					
9		further that while in operation, any operator and					
10		passenger of an all-terrain vehicle or utility-terrain					
11		vehicle shall wear a safety helmet with a securely					
12		fastened chin strap that meets the specifications and					
13		requirements established by rules adopted by the					
14		director.					
15	(b)	For purposes of this section:					
16	<u>"All</u>	-terrain vehicle" means a motor vehicle that:					
17	(1)	Is designed for off-highway operation by a single					
18		operator carrying no more than one passenger, if so					
19		designed as provided in paragraph (5) of this					
20		definition;					
21	(2)	Is fifty inches or less in width;					
22	(3)	Has an unladen weight of nine hundred pounds or less;

1	(4)	Is suspended on three or more tires;						
2	<u>(5)</u>	Has a single seat designed to be straddled by the						
3		operator, or a single seat designed to be straddled by						
4		the operator and a seat for not more than one						
5		passenger sitting behind the operator; and						
6	(6)	Has handlebars for steering control.						
7	"Far	m equipment" refers to any kind of machinery used on a						
8	farm to help with farming, including but not limited to a							
9	tractor, cultivator, plow, all-terrain vehicle, or utility-							
10	terrain vehicle.							
11	"Utility-terrain vehicle" means a motor vehicle that:							
12	(1) Is designed to be operated off highway;							
13	(2) Is sixty inches or less in width;							
14	(3)	Has an unladen weight of one thousand three hundred						
15		pounds or less;						
16	(4)	Is suspended on four to six tires;						
17	(5)	Has a steering wheel for steering control;						
18	(6)	Is equipped with roll-over protection;						
19	(7)	Accommodates one driver and one passenger sitting						
20		side-by-side; and						
21	(8)	Is equipped with seat belts for driver and passenger						
22		protection.						

1	(c)	Any	person	who	violates	this	section	shall	be	fined

- 2 \$250 for each violation.
- 3 (d) All-terrain vehicles and utility-terrain vehicles used
- 4 as farm equipment shall be regulated as farm equipment and not
- 5 as motor vehicles.
- 6 (e) All-terrain vehicles and utility-terrain vehicles used
- 7 by a city, county, or state worker while acting within the scope
- 8 of that person's official duties shall not be regulated as motor
- 9 vehicles."
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 11 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 12 begun before its effective date.
- 13 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
