Re: HB2496 HD1 SD1


HB2496 HD1 SD1, entitled "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HAWAII LABOR RELATIONS BOARD" will become law without my signature, pursuant to Section 16 of Article III of the State Constitution.

The purpose of this bill is to amend the procedures by which regular and acting members of the Hawaii Labor Relations Board are appointed by the Governor.

As this bill went through the legislative process, several state departments and agencies expressed serious concerns regarding this measure. I encourage the Legislature to further review this issue next session.

Because of the foregoing reasons, HB2496 HD1 SD1 will become law as ACT 074 (14), Session Laws of Hawaii 2014, effective April 30, 2014, without my signature.

ACT 074 H.B. NO. 2496 H.D. 1 S.D. 1

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAII LABOR RELATIONS BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 89-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended as follows:
3	1. By amending subsection (b) to read:
4	"(b) The board shall be composed of three members of which
5	(1) one member shall be representative of management, (2) one
6	member shall be representative of labor, and (3) the third
7	member, the chairperson, shall be representative of the public.
8	All members shall be appointed [by the governor] for terms of
9	six years each[Public employers and employee organizations
10	representing public employees may submit to the governor for
11	consideration names of persons to serve as members of the board
12	and the governor shall first consider these persons in selecting
13	the members of the board.] in accordance with the following
14	procedures:
15	(1) The representative of management shall be appointed by
16	the governor, who may first consider any names
17	submitted by the counties; provided that each county
18	may submit no more than one name;

1	(2) The representative of labor shall be appointed by the
2	governor from a list of three nominees submitted by
3	mutual agreement from a majority of the exclusive
4	representatives; and
5	(3) The representative of the public shall be appointed by
6	the governor."
7	2. By amending subsection (e) to read:
8	"(e) Any action taken by the board shall be by a simple
9	majority of the members of the board. All decisions of the
10	board shall be reduced to writing and shall state separately its
11	finding of fact and conclusions. Any vacancy in the board shall
12	not impair the authority of the remaining members to exercise
13	all the powers of the board. The governor may appoint an acting
14	member of the board in accordance with the procedures
15	established in subsection (b) during the temporary absence from
16	the State, temporary inability to act due to recusal, or illness
17	of any regular member. An acting member, during the acting
18	member's term of service, shall have the same powers and dúties
19	as the regular member; provided that[+
20	(1) If the regular member is the representative of
21	management or labor, then employee organizations
22	representing public employees may submit to the

1	governor for consideration names of persons to serve
2	as an acting member and the governor shall first
3	consider these persons in selecting an acting member;
4	(2) If the regular member is the representative of
5.	management, then public employers may submit to the
6	governor for consideration names of persons to serve
7	as an acting member and the governor shall first
8	consider these persons in selecting an acting member;
9	(3) Subsection (d) shall not apply to an
10	acting member[+] and
11	$[\frac{(4)}{An}]$ an acting member appointed due to a regular
12	member's recusal shall be appointed for the case in which the
13	recusal occurred, and the acting member's appointment shall
14	terminate when the final decision is filed or the case is
15	withdrawn."
16	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
18	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval,
19	and apply to appointments to the Hawaii labor relations board
20	occurring after the effective date of this Act.
