## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MINIMUM WAGE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- Section 387-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 SECTION 1. amended to read as follows: 2 "§387-2 Minimum wages. (a) Except as provided in section 3 387-9 and this section, every employer shall pay to each 4 employee employed by the employer, wages at the rate of not less 5 6 than: 7 (1) \$6.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2003; \$6.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2006; [and] 8 (2)9 (3) \$7.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2007[-]; 10 (4)\$7.75 per hour beginning January 1, 2015; 11 (5) \$8.50 per hour beginning January 1, 2016; 12 (6) \$9.25 per hour beginning January 1, 2017; and 13 \$10.10 per hour beginning January 1, 2018. (7) The hourly wage of a tipped employee may be deemed to 14 (b) 15 be increased on account of tips if the employee is paid not less 16 than:
- 17 <u>(1)</u> 25 cents;

- 1 (3) 75 cents per hour beginning January 1, 2016,
- 2 below the applicable minimum wage by the employee's employer and
- 3 the combined amount the employee receives from the employee's
- 4 employer and in tips is at least 50 cents more than the
- 5 applicable minimum wage[-]; provided that beginning January 1,
- 6 2015, the combined amount the employee receives from the
- 7 employee's employer and in tips is at least \$7.00 more than the
- 8 applicable minimum wage."
- 9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
