A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1.	The purpose	of this Act	is to	ensure the

- 3 support early intervention of autism spectrum disorders by
- 4 requiring the contracting of an actuarial analysis of the
- 5 projected costs of providing insurance coverage for the
- 6 screening, diagnosis, and treatment of autism spectrum
- 7 disorders.
- 8 SECTION 2. (a) The insurance commissioner shall contract
- 9 for the performance of an actuarial analysis by a licensed
- 10 actuary who is a member in good standing with the American
- 11 Academy of Actuaries of the projected costs of providing
- 12 insurance coverage for screening, diagnosis, and treatment of
- 13 autism spectrum disorders.
- 14 (b) The actuarial analysis shall:
- (1) Include a statement by the actuary certifying that the
- 16 techniques and methods used are generally accepted
- 17 within the actuarial profession and that the
- assumptions and cost estimates used are reasonable;

1	(2)	Provide a financial analysis of the cost of providing	
2		insurance coverage for screening, diagnosis, and	
3		treatment of autism spectrum disorders, including an	
4		estimate of the cost benefits and the cost impact to	
5		the Hawaii medicaid market; and	
6	(3)	Specifically consider the following factors and their	
7		impact on the cost of providing insurance coverage or	
8		medicaid coverage:	
9		(A) The prevalence of autism spectrum disorders	
10		compared to the prevalence of treated autism	
11		spectrum disorders;	
12		(B) The intensity and frequency of treatment provided	
13		depending on the severity of the diagnosis of	
14		autism spectrum disorders; and	
15		(C) The tiered service delivery model of applied	
16		behavior analysis as a treatment for autism	
17		spectrum disorders.	
18	(c)	The actuarial analysis shall be completed and	
19	submitted	to the insurance commissioner in sufficient time for	
20	the insurance commissioner to submit a report to the		
21	legislatu	e, including findings, recommendations, and proposed	
22	legislatio	n, if any, based on the results of the actuarial	

- 1 analysis no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the
- 2 regular session of 2015.
- 3 (d) For the purpose of contracting for the actuarial
- 4 analysis, the insurance commissioner shall be exempt from
- 5 compliance with chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 6 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$50,000 or so much
- thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2014-2015 to
- 9 contract for the performance of the actuarial analysis required
- 10 under this Act.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 12 commerce and consumer affairs for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 14 provided that section 3 shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
