STATEMENT OF OBJECTIONS TO SENATE BILL NO. 2874

Honorable Members
Twenty-Seventh Legislature
State of Hawaii

Pursuant to Section 16 of Article III of the Constitution of the State of Hawaii, I am returning herewith, without my approval, Senate Bill No. 2874, entitled "A Bill for an Act Relating to the Board of Land and Natural Resources."

The purpose of this bill is to amend the composition of the Board of Land and Natural Resources by requiring that at least one member has a background in native Hawaiian traditional and customary practices.

House Bill No. 1618, entitled "A Bill for an Act Relating to the Composition of the Board of Land and Natural Resources," which was also passed by the Legislature, is substantially similar to this bill. Because I intend to approve House Bill No. 1618, which will accomplish the purpose of this bill, there is no necessity to also approve this bill.

For the foregoing reason, I am returning Senate Bill No. 2874 without my approval.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BOARD OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 171-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 10 filling of a vacancy on the board shall also be as provided in
- 11 section 26-34. There shall be not more than three members on
- 12 the board from the same political party. At least one member of
- 13 the board shall have a background in conservation and natural
- 14 resources, as evidenced by:

- forestry, wildlife conservation, geology,
- environmental science, or marine biology; or

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1 [(b)] (c) Each member shall disclose and file with the 2 board a list of all transactions with the department of land and 3 natural resources in which the member has a direct interest. 4 The member shall also disclose all transactions with the 5 department involving any corporation, association, partnership, 6 or joint venture in which the member is an officer, partner, or 7 employee. Any member having any interest, direct or indirect, 8 in any matter before the board shall disqualify oneself from 9 voting on or participating in the discussion of the matter. [(e)] (d) The governor shall select a chairperson of the 10 board from among its members. The chairperson shall call and 11 preside at meetings and may appoint a member of the board as 12 secretary. The members of the board shall choose one of their 13 14 number to act as chairperson during the absence or disability of 15 the chairperson. 16 [(d)] (e) The members of the board shall serve without pay but shall be entitled to reimbursement for necessary expenses 17

while attending meetings and while in the discharge of their

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duties."
