## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES ADULT FOSTER HOMES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 321-11.2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$321-11.2 Adult foster homes. (a) The department of
- 4 health is authorized to certify adult foster homes for
- 5 individuals with developmental [disabilities] or intellectual
- 6 disabilities requiring [such] care beyond the individual's
- 7 eighteenth birthday. "Adult foster home" means a private family
- 8 home providing care on a twenty-four hour basis [for] to adults
- 9 with developmental or intellectual disabilities. To be
- 10 certified, an adult foster home shall [have] house not more than
- 11 two adults with developmental or intellectual disabilities who
- 12 are unrelated to the certified caregiver at the same time[, who
- 13 are unrelated to the foster family]. The director of health may
- 14 waive the two-adult limit for certification of that home as an
- 15 adult foster home; provided that the total number of adults with
- 16 developmental or intellectual disabilities in the [certified]
- 17 home shall not exceed three adults with developmental or

1	intellectual disabilities[-] who are related or unrelated to the
2	certified caregiver.
3	For the purposes of this subsection:
4	"Certified caregiver" means an individual who is twenty-one
5	years of age or older, resides in an adult foster home, and has
6	been issued by the department a valid certificate of approval to
7	provide care, training, and supervision on a twenty-four hour
8	basis to adults with developmental or intellectual disabilities.
9	"Related" means connected by legal guardianship,
10	trusteeship, blood, marriage, or a legal relationship between
11	the certified caregiver and the adult with developmental or
12	intellectual disabilities.
13	(b) To accommodate residents of a foster boarding home for
14	children with developmental or intellectual disabilities who
15	reach the age of eighteen years, where the home is certified as
16	a foster boarding home for children under section 346-17, the
<b>17</b>	director of health may waive the two_adult limit for
18	certification of that home as an adult foster home[7]; provided
19	that:
20	(1) [the] The total number of foster children with

1	such <u>a</u> dually certified home shall not exceed [five,]
2	three; and
3	(2) [ $ne$ ] No new adults may be admitted into the home while
4	there are any foster children residing in the home.
5	This subsection shall not affect the validity of the
6	certification of any adult foster home that is certified as a
7	foster boarding home under section 346-17 and in existence as of
8	the effective date of Act , Session Laws of Hawaii 2014.
9	(c) An existing adult foster home shall not be given dual
10	certification if the certification as an adult foster home
11	precedes dual certification, unless the certification as a
12	foster boarding home under section 346-17 is for a specific
13	child, as provided in the department of human services'
14	administrative rules.
15	[ <del>(b)</del> ] <u>(d)</u> The rules of the department of human services
16	adopted under authority of section 346-17, which prescribe the
17	standards of conditions and competence of operation of child
18	foster boarding homes shall apply to adult foster homes.
19	Notwithstanding chapter 91, to the contrary, the rules shall be
20	considered adopted by the department of health on July 1, 1986,
21	for the purpose of regulating adult foster care homes and shall
22	be valid until the department of health adopts rules pursuant to

- 1 chapter 91. The department of health shall adopt rules pursuant
- 2 to chapter 91 necessary for the purposes of this section.
- 3 [<del>(c)</del>] (e) Rate of payment for adult foster homes is to be
- 4 determined on the same basis as domiciliary care homes as
- 5 provided under section 346-53."
- 6 SECTION 2. Upon this Act's approval, the revisor of
- 7 statutes shall insert the number of this Act in section 321-
- 8 11.2(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1.
- 9 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
