## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRODUCTION OF RECORDS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 806D-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is									
2	amended by amending the definition of "recipient" to read as									
3	follows:									
4	""Recipient" means a person, as defined in section 701-118									
£	or a business, as defined in section 487J-1, that has conducted									
6	business or engaged in transactions or activities occurring at									
7	least in part in [this State] the state from which process was									
8	issued upon whom [eriminal] process [issued under this chapter]									
9	is properly served."									
10	SECTION 2. Section 806D-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is									
11	amended to read as follows:									
12	"[{]\$806D-4[}] Service of process issued by or in another									
13	state. (a) When a Hawaii recipient is properly served with									
14	process issued by or in another state[7] that commands the									
15	production of records in the actual or constructive possession									
16	of that person or business, and such process on its face									
17	purports to be a valid [criminal process,] process based on a

- 19 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 21 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
