A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION TO DEFINE MARRIAGE AS BETWEEN A MAN AND A WOMAN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
- 2 amendment to article I, section 23, of the Hawaii Constitution
- 3 to define marriage as only between a man and a woman, as husband
- 4 and wife.
- 5 The legislature finds that the unique social institution of
- 6 marriage involving the legal relationship of matrimony between a
- 7 man and a woman is a protected relationship of fundamental and
- 8 unequaled importance to the State, the nation, and society. In
- 9 1997, the legislature proposed an amendment to the Hawaii
- 10 Constitution by adding a new section relating to marriage. The
- 11 proposed amendment was ratified by Hawaii voters in the general
- 12 election of November 3, 1998, and provides that the legislature
- 13 "shall have the power to reserve marriage to opposite sex
- 14 couples". Although state law currently provides that a valid
- 15 marriage contract exists only between a man and a woman, a
- 16 constitutional amendment that expressly limits marriage to a

- 1 legally sanctioned union only between a man and a woman is
- 2 necessary to provide further clarification and specificity.
- 3 SECTION 2. Article 1, section 23, of the Hawaii
- 4 Constitution is amended to read as follows:
- 5 "Section 23. [The legislature shall have the power to
- 6 reserve marriage to opposite-sex couples.] Marriage is a legally
- 7 sanctioned union only between a man and a woman."
- 8 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
- 9 be as follows:
- 10 "Shall marriage be defined as a legally sanctioned union
- only between a man and a woman?"
- 12 SECTION 4. Constitutional material to be repealed is
- 13 bracketed and stricken. New constitutional material is
- 14 underscored.
- 15 SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect upon
- 16 compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Hawaii
- 17 Constitution.
