
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 321-11.2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3 "(a) The department of health is authorized to certify
4 adult foster homes for developmentally disabled individuals
5 requiring such care beyond the eighteenth birthday. "Adult
6 foster home" means a private home providing care on a twenty-
7 four hour basis for adults with developmental disabilities. To
8 be certified, an adult foster home shall have not more than
9 [~~two~~] three adults with developmental disabilities at the same
10 time, who are unrelated to the foster family. To accommodate
11 residents of a foster boarding home for children with
12 developmental disabilities who reach the age of eighteen years,
13 where the home is certified as a foster boarding home for
14 children under section 346-17, the director of health may waive
15 the [~~two~~] three adult limit for certification of that home as an
16 adult foster home[~~7~~]; provided that: (1) the number of foster
17 children and adults in such dually certified home shall not
18 exceed [~~five~~] six, and (2) no new adults may be admitted into




1 the home while there are any foster children residing in the
2 home."

3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
