## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, part II, subpart C, Hawaii
2	Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be
3	appropriately designated and to read as follows:
4	"§302A- Career and technology center program. (a)
5	The department shall establish and administer a career and
6	technology center program for high school students. The program
7	shall include career and technology centers established as
8	follows:
9	(1) Four on the island of Oahu;
10	(2) Two on the island of Hawaii;
11	(3) One each on the islands of Maui and Kauai; and
12	(4) One auxiliary center each on the islands of Molokai
13	and Lanai.
14	(b) For purposes of this section:
15	"Auxiliary center" means a program at a high school that
16	provides courses in at least one of the areas offered by career
17	and technology centers established pursuant to this section.

"Car	eer a	nd technology center" means a vocational high
school pr	ogram	that:
(1)	Each	student attends for half of each school day;
	prov	ided that the student spends the other half of
	each	school day in academic studies at the student's
	high	school; and
(2)	Prov	ides courses in areas such as:
	<u>(A)</u>	Arts or graphic communication, which may include
		commercial art and graphic design;
	<u>(B)</u>	Construction, which may include carpentry and
		electrical occupations;
	<u>(C)</u>	Health services, which may include dental
		occupations and health science technology;
	<u>(D)</u>	Hospitality, which may include culinary arts;
	<u>(E)</u>	Information technology, which may include
		computer information systems;
	<u>(F)</u>	Manufacturing, which may include metal
		technology;
	<u>(G)</u>	Personal services, which may include cosmetology
		and protective services; and
	<u>(H)</u>	Transportation, which may include automotive
		technology and collision repair.

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1	(c) Funding for the program shall be made available
2	pursuant to the weighted student formula established in section
3	302A-1303.6.
4	(d) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
5	91 to implement this section."
6	SECTION 2. The department of education shall submit a
7	report to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the
8	convening of the regular session of 2014 on the development and
9	implementation of the career and technology center program.
10	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
