3	(d) Criteria used to establish overall repair and

7	(2) Whether a repair or maintenance project is required:	
8	(A) For health or safety reasons $[+]$, including	
9	critical health or safety reasons;	
10	(B) To comply with legal mandates;	
11	(C) To comply with current building codes; or	
12	(D) For preventive maintenance reasons;	
13	provided that in developing criteria, consideration shall be	
14	given to school facilities that were more than twenty-five years
