A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOL ENTRANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 302A-1159, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended to read as follows: 2 "§302A-1159 Physical and dental examination required. 3 child shall be admitted to any elementary, middle or 4 intermediate, or high school for the first time in the State 5 unless the child presents to the appropriate school official a 6 report from a licensed physician or advanced practice registered 7 nurse of the results of a physical examination, and a report 8 from a licensed dentist of a dental examination, performed 9 within a year of the date of entry into school [-]; provided that **10** for a child with a developmental disability, the child's 11 licensed primary care provider shall annually make the 12 determination as to whether a dental examination is necessary. 13 A child may enter school provisionally upon submitting written 14 documentation from a licensed physician, advanced practice 15 registered nurse, licensed dentist, or other authorized 16 representative of the department of health stating that the 17 child is in the process of undergoing a physical or dental 18 HB1131 HD1 HMS 2013-1892

- 1 examination. Further documentation showing that the required
- 2 physical [examination has] and dental examinations have been
- 3 completed shall be submitted to the appropriate school official
- 4 no later than three months after the child first entered the
- 5 school."
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 302A-1160, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 "\$302A-1160 Student's health record. The department of
- 9 education shall provide student health record forms for
- 10 immunization and physical [examination] and dental examinations
- 11 to the schools, private physicians, advanced practice registered
- 12 nurses, private dentists, and authorized personnel of the
- 13 department of health."
- 14 SECTION 3. Section 302A-1161, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 "\$302A-1161 Notification for noncompliance. (a) If a
- 17 child does not complete the immunizations required under section
- 18 302A-1154 or the physical [examination] or dental examinations
- 19 required under section 302A-1159 within the [period] periods
- 20 provided by [section] sections 302A-1155 and 302A-1159 after
- 21 provisional entry into school, the administrator of the school
- 22 shall cause a notice to be sent to the parent or guardian of the



child stating that if the required immunizations or physical or 1 dental examination is not completed within thirty days of the 2 date of the notice, the child shall not be admitted to school. 3 (b) If a child with a developmental disability does not 4 complete a dental examination deemed necessary by the child's 5 licensed primary care provider pursuant to section 302A-1159 6 within the period provided by section 302A-1159 after 7 provisional entry into school, the administrator of the school 8 shall cause a notice to be sent to the parent or guardian of the 9 child stating that if the required dental examination is not 10 completed within ninety days of the date of notice, the child 11 shall not be admitted to school." 12 SECTION 4. Section 302A-1162, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 14 The department of health shall adopt rules under "(a) 15 chapter 91 relating to immunization, physical [examination,] and 16 dental examinations, and tuberculin testing under sections 302A-17 1154 to 302A-1163. Immunizations required, and the manner and 18 frequency of their administration, shall conform with recognized 19 standard medical practices. The list of diseases and minimum 20

- 1 1163 may be revised whenever the department of health deems it
- 2 necessary for the protection of public health."
- 3 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
