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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. There are appropriated or authorized from the  
3 sources of funding indicated below to departmental  
4 administration and budget division (BUF 101) the following sums  
5 or so much thereof as may be necessary to fund for fiscal  
6 biennium 2013-2015 all collective bargaining cost items in the  
7 agreements negotiated with the exclusive bargaining  
8 representatives of collective bargaining unit (10):

18 SECTION 13. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided  
19 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is  
20 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds  
21 shall be paid wholly or proportionally, as the case may be, from  
22 the respective funds.



1 SECTION 14. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act  
2 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2014, and  
3 June 30, 2015, of the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of  
4 those dates.

5 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
