A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 291-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) Every motorcycle and moped moving under its own power
4	on a public highway shall at all times be equipped with a
5	muffler in constant operation to prevent any excessive or
6	unusual noise and no such muffler or exhaust system shall be
7	equipped with a cutout, bypass, or similar device. No person
8	shall modify the exhaust system of a motorcycle or a moped in a
9	manner which will amplify or increase the noise emitted by the
10	motor of such motorcycle or moped above that emitted by the
11	muffler originally installed on the motorcycle or moped [except
12	$_{lap{a}}$]. No person shall modify the exhaust system of a moped
13	manufactured after December 31, 2013, in a manner that will
14	amplify or increase the noise emitted by the moped above that
15	emitted by the original mufflers indicated on the label attached
16	to the moped in accordance with Title 40 Code of Federal
17	Regulations section 204.158. A motorcycle or moped that:

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2014.
