A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CERTIFICATION AND LICENSURE FEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the department of 2 human services continues to experience growth in enrollment 3 across its programs. Since 2008, enrollment in the temporary assistance for needy families and temporary assistance for other 4 5 needy families programs has increased approximately nineteen per 6 cent and the number of general assistance beneficiaries has 7 increased by twenty-four per cent. Enrollment in the department 8 of human services' programs is expected to continue to rise. The legislature finds that other state governments charge 9 fees for licensures and certifications as revenue-producing 10 activities to offset their human services budget deficits. 11 12 The department of human services and the department of 13 health are working towards consolidating major oversight functions within the department of health, including licensing 14 15 and certification functions for community care foster family 16 homes, community case management agencies, and adult day care centers in the State. The department of human services, which 17 18 retains oversight and major functions of those programs until



- 1 July 1, 2014, and retains oversight of the training and
- 2 certification of nurse aides after that date, is directed by
- 3 this Act to recommend the fees for these licensing and
- 4 certification functions.
- 5 The legislature further finds that the fee recommendations
- 6 by the department of human services will facilitate a smooth
- 7 transition of major functions from the department of human
- 8 services to the department of health by July 1, 2014, by
- 9 providing the department of health with an immediate basis for
- 10 collection of licensure and certification fees.
- 11 SECTION 2. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 13 and to read as follows:
- 14 "§346- Fee assessments. As part of any plan for the
- 15 transfer of jurisdiction over community-based case management
- 16 agencies, community care foster family homes, and adult day care
- 17 centers from the department of human services to the department
- 18 of health pursuant to Act 93, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, the
- 19 director of human services shall gather relevant data and
- 20 recommend reasonable fees to be assessed for certification,
- 21 licensure, certification renewal, or license renewal for
- 22 certified or licensed providers of home and community-based case

5	SECTION 3. Section 346-46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
6	amended to read as follows:	
7	"§346-46 Certified nurse aides; training programs and	
8	recertifi	cation. The director shall:
9	(1)	Approve training programs for nurse aides and ensure
10		that the training programs comply with all applicable
11		federal and state requirements;
12	(2)	Approve and arrange for the recertification process
13		for nurse aides who work in medicare or medicaid
14		certified nursing facilities;
15	(3)	Approve and arrange for the recertification process
16		for nurse aides who work in state-licensed or state-
17		certified health care settings; [and]
18	(4)	Require recertification not less than every two years.
19		The number of continuing education hours required for
20		recertification shall not exceed twenty-four hours,
21		except as specified by federal law[-]; and

1 (5) Recommend fees for training and recertification of
2 nurse aides pursuant to this section."

SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
