## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FORTIETH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2	general obligation bonds in the sum of \$5,500,000 or so much
3	thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4	as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2013-2014
5	for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for
6	the fortieth representative district, as follows:
7	1. To be expended by the department of education:
8	A. James Campbell high school
9	Electrical systems upgrades to all

14	B. James Campbell high school
15	Construction and installation of a
16	new track and field turf.

10	SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
11	improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
12	the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
13	made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
14	unencumbered as of June 30, 2016, shall lapse as of that date.
15	SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital
16	improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by
17	the designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.
18	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
