### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ADJUNCT TEACHERS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§302A- Adjunct teachers. (a) The department may
5	employ individuals as adjunct teachers in lieu of teachers
6	licensed by the Hawaii teacher standards board; provided that
7	during any school year not more than thirty per cent of the
8	total number of teachers at any particular school may be
9	composed of adjunct teachers, unless a waiver is obtained from a
10	district superintendent.
11	(b) The department may hire an individual as an adjunct
12	teacher if the individual has at least one year of teaching
13	experience at a post-secondary educational institution that is
14	accredited by an accrediting body recognized by the Secretary of
15	Education.
16	(c) Individuals employed as adjunct teachers shall be
17	exempt from chapter 89 and the licensing requirement of section
18	302A-805."

2	amended b	y amending subsection (f) to read as follows:	
3	"(f)	The following individuals shall not be included in	
4	any appropriate bargaining unit or be entitled to coverage under		
5	this chapter:

7	(2)	Member of any board or commission; provided that	
8		nothing in this paragraph shall prohibit a member of a	
9		collective bargaining unit from serving on a governing	
10		board of a charter school, on the state public charter	
11		school commission, or as a charter school authorizer	
12		established under chapter 302D;	
13	(3)	Top-level managerial and administrative personnel,	
14		including the department head, deputy or assistant to	
15		a department head, administrative officer, director,	
16		or chief of a state or county agency or major	
17		division, and legal counsel;	
18	(4)	Secretary to top-level managerial and administrative	
19		personnel under paragraph (3);	
20	(5)	Individual concerned with confidential matters	
21		affecting employee-employer relations;	



1	(6)	Part-time employee working less than twenty hours per
2		week, except part-time employees included in unit (5);
3	(7)	Temporary employee of three months' duration or less;
4	(8)	Employee of the executive office of the governor or a
5		household employee at Washington Place;
6	(9)	Employee of the executive office of the lieutenant
7		governor;
8	(10)	Employee of the executive office of the mayor;
9	(11)	Staff of the legislative branch of the State;
10	(12)	Staff of the legislative branches of the counties,
11		except employees of the clerks' offices of the
12		counties;
13	(13)	Any commissioned and enlisted personnel of the Hawaii
14		national guard;
15	(14)	Inmate, kokua, patient, ward, or student of a state
16		institution;
17	(15)	Student help;
18	(16)	Staff of the Hawaii labor relations board;
19	(17)	Employees of the Hawaii national guard youth challenge
20		academy; [ <del>or</del> ]
21	(18)	Employees of the office of $elections[-]$ ; or
22	(19)	Adjunct teacher of the department of education."
