# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DIABETES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§321- Diabetes reporting. (a) The department of
5	health, in collaboration with the department of human services,
6	shall identify goals and benchmarks and develop departmental
7	plans to reduce the incidence of diabetes in the State, improve
8	diabetes care, and reduce complications associated with
9	diabetes.
10	(b) The department of health, in collaboration with the
11	department of human services, shall submit an annual report to
12	the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening
13	of each regular session on the following:
14	(1) The health, societal, and financial impacts that
15	diabetes of all types has on the State, counties, the
16	department of health, and the department of human
17	services, including:
18	(A) The number of persons with diabetes;

1		(B)	The number of participants in diabetes education
2			and treatment programs administered by the
3			department of health and the department of human
4			services;
5		(C)	The costs associated with diabetes education and
6			treatment programs administered by the department
7			of health and the department of human services,
8			including medicaid; and
9		(D)	The costs to the department of health and the
10			department of human services associated with
11			diabetes education and treatment as compared to
12			the costs associated with education and treatment
13			of other chronic diseases;
14	(2)	<u>An a</u>	ssessment of the effectiveness of diabetes
15		educ	ation and treatment activities, including the
16		amou	nt and source of any funding appropriated by the
17		legi	slature for these activities;
18	(3)	A de	scription of the level of coordination between the
19		depa	rtment of health and the department of human
20		serv	ices on activities to manage, treat, and prevent
21		diab	etes and associated complications; and

1	(4)	Any proposed legislation intended to reduce the impact
2		of diabetes, pre-diabetes, and related diabetes
3		complications in Hawaii, including recommended
4		appropriations; provided that the report shall
5		identify expected outcomes of the proposed
6		legislation."

8	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
