## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATEWIDE TRAFFIC CODE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows: 3 "(b) As used in this section, "emergency vehicle" means a police or fire department vehicle, state law enforcement 4 5 vehicle, ocean safety vehicle, emergency medical services 6 vehicle, freeway service patrol vehicle, state civil defense 7 vehicle, county emergency management vehicle, or [a] tow truck. 8 Violation of subsection (a) shall not be subject to 9 section 287-20, relating to furnishing proof of financial 10 responsibility. 11 A violation of subsection (a) shall constitute a violation 12 if no death or injury results from the violation. 13 If a death or injury occurs and is attributable to the 14 driver of the vehicle for a violation of subsection (a), then 15 the driver shall instead be charged under section 707-702 for 16 manslaughter, section 707-702.5 for negligent homicide in the

first degree; section 707-703 for negligent homicide in the

second degree; section 707-704 for negligent homicide in the

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- 1 third degree; section 707-705 for negligent injury in the first
- 2 degree; or section 707-706 for negligent injury in the second
- 3 degree, as applicable."
- 4 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

## Report Title:

Emergency Vehicle; Move Over; Civil Defense; Emergency Management

## Description:

Adds civil defense, state law enforcement, and county emergency management vehicles to the definition of "emergency vehicle" under the move over law. Adds a charge of manslaughter as a possible offense when a driver does not move over and kills an emergency responder. (HB1308 HD1)

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
