A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTROLLED-ACCESS FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 264-64, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"§264-64 Design of controlled-access facility and
4	regulation, restriction, or prohibition of access; penalty. (a)
5	The director of transportation may so design any controlled-
6	access facility and so regulate, restrict, or prohibit access as
7	to best serve the traffic for which such facility is intended.
8	In this connection, the director may divide and separate any

- 9 controlled-access facility into separate roadways by the
- 10 construction of raised curbing, central dividing sections, or
- 11 other physical separations, or by designating the separate
- 12 roadways by signs, markers, stripes, and the proper lane for the
- 13 traffic by appropriate signs, markers, stripes, and other
- 14 devices.
- 15 The director of transportation shall designate the (b)
- 16 right shoulder lane of the east-bound lanes of the controlled-
- access facility known as H-1 for use by through traffic 17
- 18 beginning at exit 15A and ending at exit 1. The director's





- 1 designation pursuant to this subsection shall be effective on
- 2 weekdays from 5:30 a.m. until at least 10:00 a.m. except for
- 3 state or federal holidays.
- 4 (c) No person shall have any right of ingress or egress
- 5 to, from, or across controlled-access facilities to or from
- 6 abutting lands, except at the designated points at which access
- 7 may be permitted, upon such terms and conditions as may be
- 8 specified by the director. Any person who violates this section
- 9 shall be fined not more than \$250 or imprisoned not more than
- 10 three months, or both."
- 11 SECTION 2. The director of transportation shall seek
- 12 approval of the designation of the right shoulder lane of the
- 13 east-bound controlled-access facility known as H-1 for through
- 14 traffic pursuant to this Act from the United States Department
- 15 of Transportation as required by federal law.
- 16 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 18 provided that the director of transportation's designation under
- 19 section 264-64(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall not be

- 1 implemented until approval therefor is obtained from the United
- 2 States Department of Transportation.
