A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ANTIQUE GAMBLING DEVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 712-1226, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "\$712-1226 Possession of a gambling device. (1) A person 4 commits the offense of possession of a gambling device if the 5 person manufactures, sells, transports, places, possesses, or 6 conducts or negotiates any transaction affecting or designed to 7 affect ownership, custody, or use of any gambling device, 8 knowing it is to be used in the advancement of gambling activity 9 [which] that is not social gambling. **10** (2) This section shall not apply to the possession of any 11 antique slot machine not intended to be used in the advancement 12 of gambling activity. 13 (3) For the purposes of this section, "antique slot 14 machine" means any gambling device that operates, either 15 completely automatically or with the aid of some physical act by the player, as a result of the insertion of a coin or other 16

object, and is twenty-five years or older from the date of
