A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SENTENCE OF IMPRISONMENT FOR SEXUAL ASSAULT OF A MINOR AGE TWELVE OR YOUNGER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that children are a 2 vulnerable group that needs to be protected from sexual 3 predators. Sexual crimes committed against children age twelve 4 and younger are particularly egregious, given that children in 5 that age range are incapable of legally consenting to any sexual 6 acts. The legislature therefore finds that imposing a mandatory 7 minimum term of imprisonment upon persons convicted of certain 8 sexual crimes against children age twelve and younger is 9 warranted, and serves as a deterrent to future conduct. 10 The purpose of this Act is to establish a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment for persons age eighteen and older who have 11 12 been convicted of certain sexual offenses against a child age 13 twelve or younger.
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 706, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 15 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated

- 1 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun before its effective date.

- 5 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
