A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE FORTY-SEVENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2	general obligation bonds in the sum of \$24,155,000 or so much
3	thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4	as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2013-2014,
5	and \$7,892,000 for fiscal year 2014-2015, as indicated, for the
6	purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-seventh
7	representative district, as follows:

6	(2) From the appropriations made for fiscal year 2014-
7	2015, all moneys unencumbered as of June 30, 2017,
8	shall lapse as of that date.
9	SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
10	capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
11	expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of
12	this Act.
13	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
