- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 2 the attorney general for the purpose of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 2. The sum hereinabove may be paid to the
- 4 respective persons, or for the satisfaction of the identified
- 5 case, and in several amounts hereinabove set forth or in lesser
- 6 amounts deemed appropriate, upon checks issued by the
- 7 comptroller; provided the department of education shall obtain
- 8 the approval of the attorney general before payment of any claim
- 9 can be made.
- 10 SECTION 3. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the
- 11 appropriation made in this Act as of the close of business on
- 12 June 30, 2014, shall lapse.
