
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and the
4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
5 2014-2015 for the University of Hawaii to implement a
6 scholarship program and other programs in partnership with the
7 Washington Center; provided that:

8 (1) An eligible student shall be a student at any of the
9 University of Hawaii system campuses;

10 (2) An eligible student shall meet the University of
11 Hawaii requirements to qualify for resident tuition;

12 (3) The University of Hawaii may establish other
13 scholarship and program eligibility requirements; and

14 (4) The University of Hawaii vice-president for student
15 affairs and university/community relations and the
16 University of Hawaii liaison for the Washington Center
17 shall be responsible for the implementation of the



1 programs, including establishing eligibility criteria
2 and recipient selection.

3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University
4 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
