A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE TWELFTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:
